
TOP 5 BABY MONITORS

1. Infant Optics DXR-8 Video Baby Monitor

If you are looking for top-rated or mostly used baby monitor than you will not find any other monitor than Infant Optics DXR-8. The unique part of Infant Optics DXR-8 is that it has lens changing ability. Although it comes with a lens (which will provide regular viewing as well as zoom option) you can always buy a good lens separately. The panoramic feature can be useful when your baby starts to play or move anywhere.



Furthermore, you can monitor the temperature of the room with Infant Optics DXR-8. It has an audio feature too but if you turn off the audio mode, it can save 50% of the battery. You can also talk to your baby through the monitor. You can't take pictures or record video but this monitor isn't loud. This means it will not startle your sleep.

2. V-Tech DM111 Audio Baby Monitor

V-Tech is popular because of its longrange digital sound monitor. It uses the latest technology which can transmit sounds as clear as a crystal. You can even hear the slightest movement which helps to understand how comfortably the baby is sleeping.

It requires 2 AA batteries to fully operate. Furthermore, you can set it to beep mode when your V-Tech's batteries are dying or you went too far which results in lose connection. The parent unit also has a belt clip so that you can carry this device with you.



In addition, it has a 5-level sound indicator that comes handy when you have muted the device. It informs the level of the sound in the room. Some parents complain about the voice of V-Tech. They complain that the voice is loud.

3. Hello Baby Wireless Video Monitor

In the world of wireless technology, Hello Baby also made a wireless video monitor that has a high range (about 960ft). You can also monitor the temperature of the baby's room through this baby monitor.

Hello Baby also uses the latest wireless technology which provides high-quality video (if the monitor is in the range). Not only that, it provides the high-quality sound as well so that you can hear the slightest movement of your baby.

The best part is that Hello Baby is a plug-and-go device. This means there is no hectic of software or connectivity problems. When you turn on the device, the camera will pick up the connection automatically.



Furthermore, if you have more kids then you can watch all of them by connecting the three other cameras.

This device can work up to 8 hours. This means you need to recharge it at least once a day. However, if you run on a power-saving mode, it can work up to 12 hours.

4. BabySense Video Baby Monitor

When you hear the word baby monitor, you might be thinking of sound but that is not all. Babysense Video Baby Monitor will even show you your baby's movement. The parent unit is portable which means you can take it anywhere. It is lightweight and uses rechargeable lithium-ion batteries.

The unique part of Babysense is that it has infrared night vision so that you can see properly at night. The sound is crystal clear and not to forget the long-range (up to 900ft). Moreover, you can even talk with your baby because of the two-way communication feature.



5. Summer Infant Video Monitor

Last but not least, Summer Infant helps you to monitor every movement of your baby. The biggest advantage is that it is easy to use. The parent unit has a large as well as a smooth touchscreen (3.5-inch). Not to forget that it also has a long transmission range (up to 400ft).

Furthermore, you can mount the camera on a wall. It is more secure, unlike other baby monitors. You can control everything with just one touch. In other words, you will find all the controls on the touchscreen.
